## **Keep students motivated**

Students crave timely feedback. Try grading questions as they are responding and allowing them to re-attempt once.



## **Maintain control of assignments**

Change class settings for student collaboration, text chunking, and retrying answers.



## **Model with real student work**

Anonymize student names and project your grading screen to discuss how answers might be improved.



## **See research projects unfold**

When students import text to Research Projects, you'll have full visibility into what sources students use.



## **Inspire a joy for reading**

Encourage students to pick a text from the Independent Reading Library when they finish activities early.



## **Help those who need it most**

Differentiate instruction by scaffolding your assignment more for students who struggle. Add Extra Help notes just for them.



## **Unleash peer learning**

Urge students to share notes with the class, and reply to each other to have a discussion.
